We have 12 students and 5 children from Korea, China, California and Washington States and we are in 5th weeks of lecture phase. We all have great expectation from God for each of us and excited what God will do in us during 12 weeks of lecture phase. I still remember what God did to us during the DTS 2017 and it was absolutely His grace and mercy to meet all our needs (mental, emotional, spiritual, financial, etc), healed and set us free from all the hurts from the past and filled us with His Spirit and gave us renewed hope and new vision. Please pray with us during lecture phase so that God would do greater things in us and all of us could encounter God in a very special way and for 8 weeks of outreach after 12 weeks of lecture phase.

I received a phone call from Korea in mid-January and they informed me that my oldest sister was admitted to ICU in hospital. I was debating whether should I go to Korea or not. I didn't want to regret to not go to see her before something happen and yet, I hesitated to face another sibling's death cause I already lost two brothers in two and half years ago. I just came out of grief over my two brother's death and I didn't want to face another one. My sister was in hospital over a month and she went to be with the Lord very peacefully. "Thank you for coming to see me!" This was her last word to me. Even though it wasn't easy to face my sister's death but I know where she is now where there is no pains and heart aches....!
