★ Baptism and sharing clothing for donation



On Saturday, September 22, Rev. Joo Young Kim, a pastor at 153 Church in Atlanta, visited us and held a baptism ceremony. A total of eight members of the Church were baptized.

Pastor Joo Young Kim and his wife sang praise and gave a Bible as a gift to all the members who were baptized. Out of all the members at the Church, only one had a Bible. Now by sharing the Bible as a gift, more people will be able to read the Word and have faith in the Lord.

After the baptism service, we shared clothing that we received from America to the children that attended our Church. We have had three baptism services so far, and until now there was only one 14-year old teenager who attended, but this time I was delighted to see that many children showed up and received clothing.

Taking steps for the next five years-

With the help of the Holy Spirit, we want the people of Paraguay to understand their true identity. Due to their current circumstances, people are "reacting" to their situations rather living a purposeful life. Even though there are many obstacles such as lack of enthusiasm and persistence from the people and domestic violence, drug abuse, and increasing single-parent households, I believe that the Holy Spirit can help them find their true identity in Christ.

I want to especially thank Rev. Joo Young Kim and his wife Hee Ok Joo. Many of our children at Church were deeply moved not just by the many gifts they brought, but by the way they lead praise and worshipped God on Saturday meetings and Sunday worship services. Although it was a short encounter, we were incredibly blessed by their presence.

★ Purchasing a building to reconstruct Sanctuary

The building we are currently using will be remodeled as a self-reliance center and student dormitory. Since most of the residential buildings are in poor conditions, whenever it rains, they flood. Even when there is no rain, there is always extreme humidity and mosquitoes within the buildings.

In addition, the current building lacks a proper sewage system, resulting in malfunctioning bathrooms. With the purchase of the new building, we hope to take care of these issues. The building is approximately \$11,250.















The self-reliance center will be used to reach out to people residing in Bañado Sur. We will be targeting about 3,000 families (or ~12,000 population), more specifically, to provide high school graduates with job training. We firmly believe that spiritual recovery without financial stability, will only be short-lived. Being able to do all this is thanks to all donations and prayer from our supporters.

All the work we did thus far is to have hope in Christ Jesus and introduce Him to the people. All the work, in glory to God, goes to workers of the site and members of the Church. Only way to continue this success is by centering all the work around Christ Jesus. We urge you to part take in this mission, all the pastors, missionaries and members, so that you share the fruits of joy from this work. We don't force humility upon ourselves to be humble, rather, because we know we are weak, we entrust everything to the Lord. We sincerely thank all the love and prayers from JSBMF members. We hope to see that JSBMF grow to be a community that continues to stand with Christ Jesus and that He will be with the community in all its works. Shalom.
