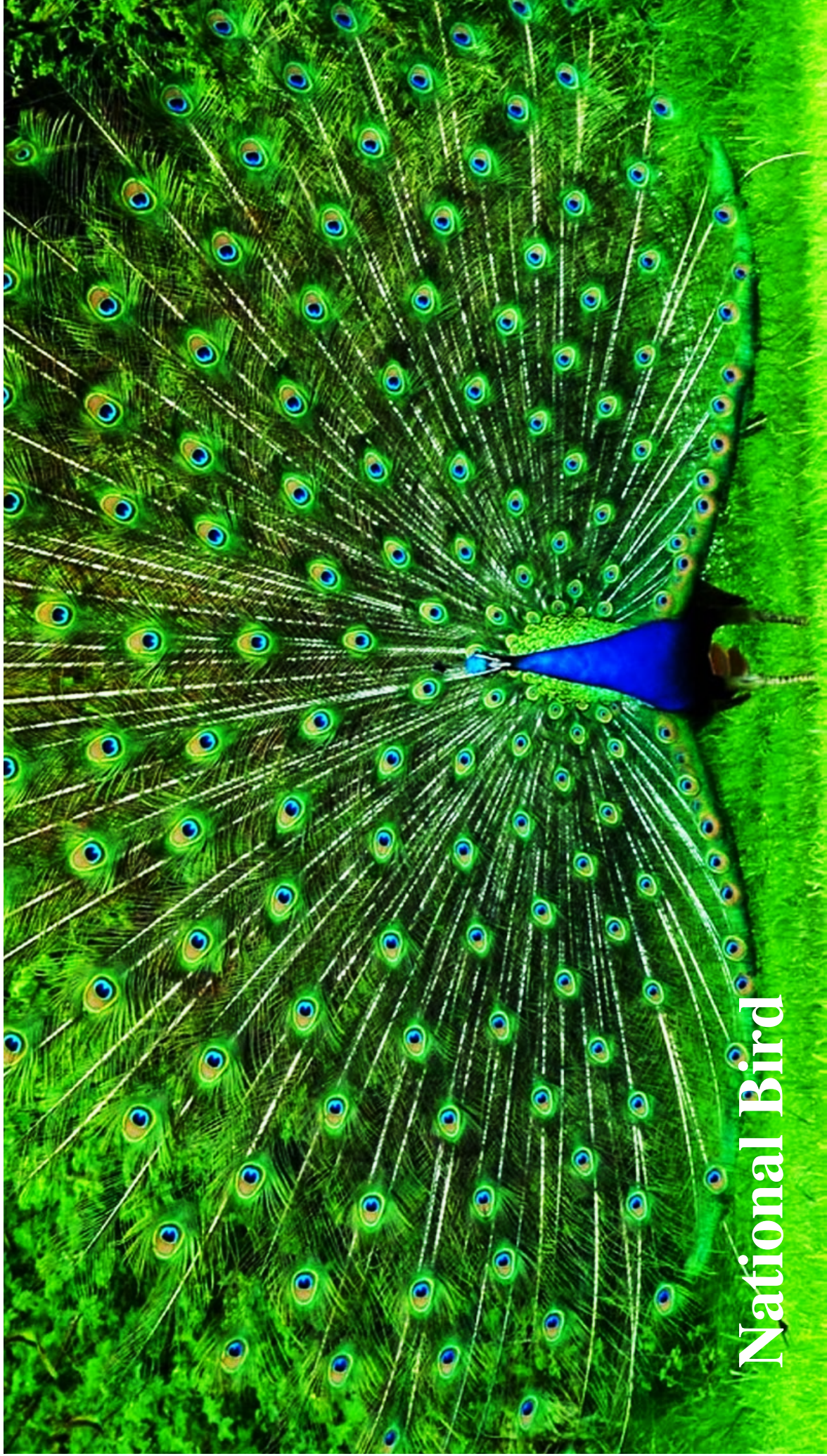

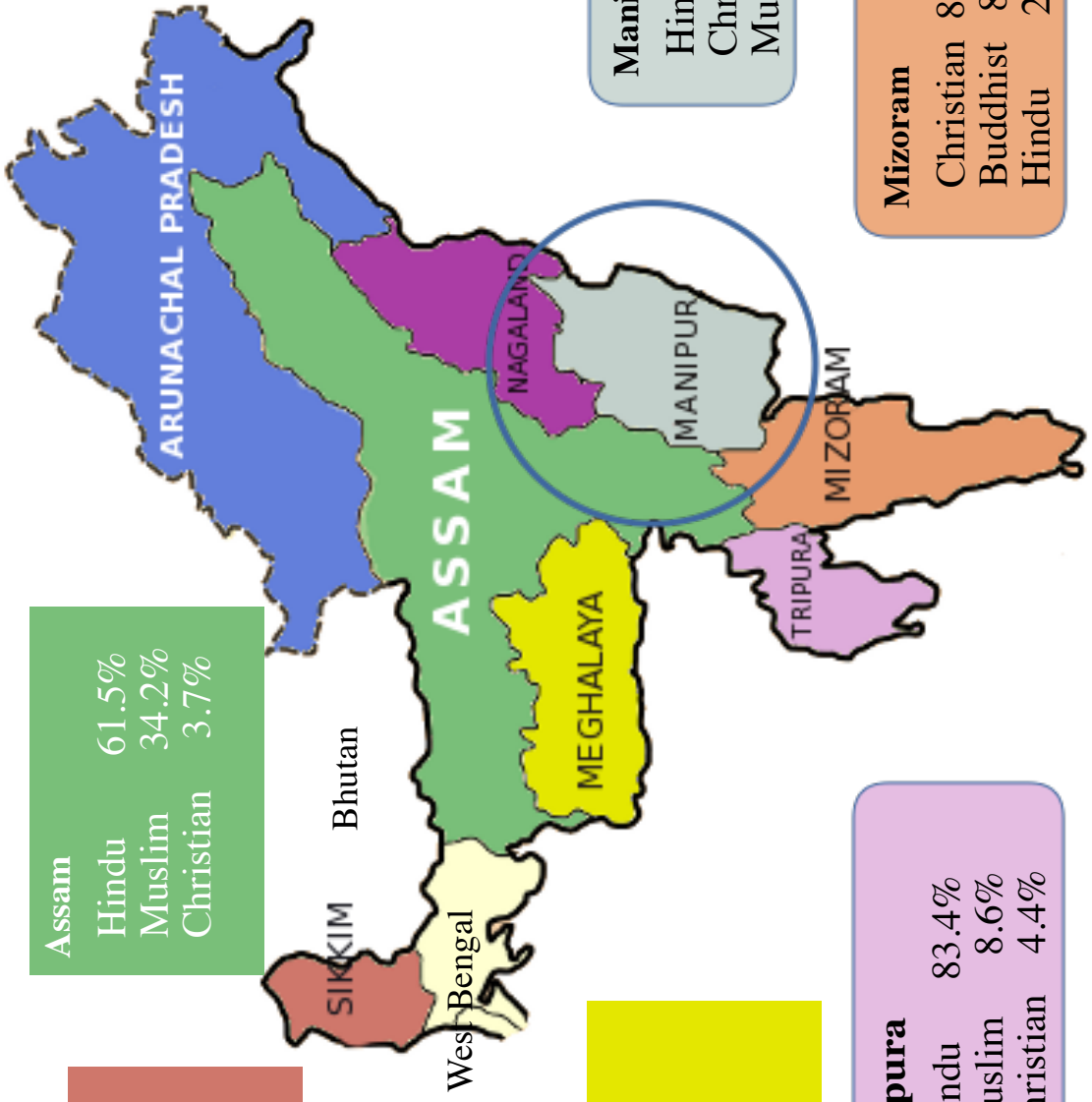

Church Planting Movements

- ① In absolute obedience to the Word of God;
 - ② a participative worship/Bible study by multiple members;
 - ③ unpaid leaders who depend entirely upon God to be the provider;
 - ④ following after the concept of a house cell church of NT;
 - ⑤ with the divine vision from Mt.28.18-20; Mk 16.15-20; and Acts 1.8.
- Totally committed to preaching the gospel to their own tribes with a spirit of “worship, praise, testimony, fellowship and teaching when getting together; and witnessing to the unbelievers when dispersed” even in the face of persecution and troubles without lessening the flame of evangelization.

 - **Unreached people group: Christ followers less than 2% of population and less than 5% professing Christians;**
 - **Why India?**
About 1/3 or 2300 unreached people groups out of a total of 7000 in the world remain now in India alone, making India the single most unreached area of the world.

Three Korean American missionaries in collaboration with three local pastors/professors inaugurated School of Church Planters in 3/2018 and graduated in Nov. Five graduated. The second term is expected in 3/2019.

- After worship, how to help the church was discussed with the church workers.
- This church was very weak, troubled with fear of persecution without any economic support as they came to this detached place, cast out by their families, employment and tribal communities due to their conversion to Christianity.



- Planned to invest in three auto-rickshaws (8-10 seats) to be purchased, owned and managed by the church.
- The first one to be bought through joint investment; the next two to be realized over the next few months by two missionaries.
- To provide income for three members and some monthly income to the church treasury.



- **Overflowing young people** everywhere in India vs China to be tapped as disciples of Jesus;

- **Education** is the most lucrative investment in India.

- Humble, eager to learn, low cost, respectful to the aged and obedient to the law and instruction. **Good candidates as disciples of Jesus.**

- Yet, the **caste system** still remains embued in their Hindu culture and society, hampering the maturity in Christian faith.
