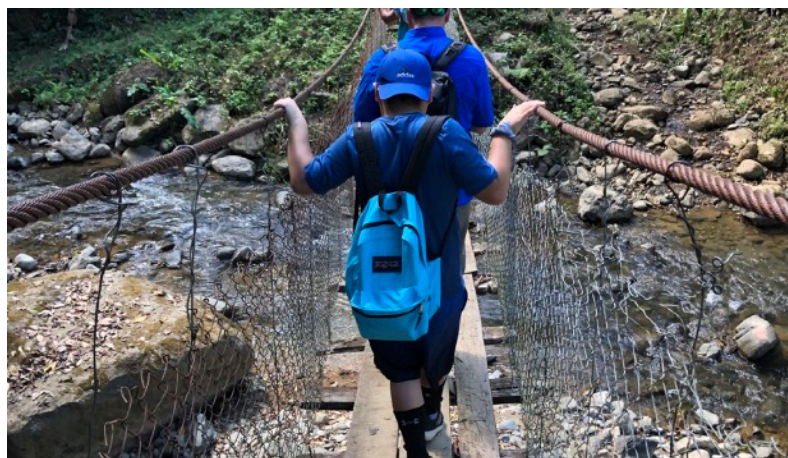
## Life in Costa Rica
