Dear Officers and Supporters of JSBMF

Hallelujah!

Greetings to the JSBMF family in the name of Jesus Christ.

Recently, I received some beautiful photographs of the autumn leaves from the United States. I was fascinated by the radiant colored leaves. There are not many leaves here in Paraguay, so I was mesmerized by all the yellow and red that was present in nature in the U.S. While doing so, I reminded myself that “As the leaves turn red, the end will be fulfilled like the fire of the Lord.”

★ Vocational & Activity Center

I was a little late in sending the mission report by early October.

After six months of flooding and being on the road, I finally was able to go to church, sort things out, and start renovating it. During these rough times, I was strengthened by the churches and the Christians who sent relief donations. With all the support, the existing church was reconstructed to be used as a vocational training center and activity space.

Starting on January 6, 2020, I will be teaching after school, beauty techniques and taekwondo to the local children.

The disaster relief donations totaled \$15,819, which were sent from 10 churches, 1 cell group, 2 institutions, and 11 individuals. Thank you very much.



★ The Hope Building and Restroom Renovation Movement

As the vocational training center is being built, there are materials from the existing buildings. Trying to think of how to reuse those materials, I thought it would be good to bless the congregation members and serve the community with the Hope Building and Restroom Rehabilitation Movement. The first family that was helped was a child that has been faithful for last five years. I gained a lot of experience and knowledge during the first time. Many things are needed to continue this type of evangelism for the community. However, if a family is eligible for a new home and financial support, I want to continue this outreach as long as I can.

So far, we were able to build two homes, spending \$5,500 per family. We also completed a bathroom renovation that cost \$600. As we continue with the church construction, I believe we can gain more construction knowledge and be more cost efficient as we continue forward. It is truly a blessing to be able to bless the families with new homes.



★ Soccer match church

Our young children played soccer with a local church in the countryside.

It is a pity that I cannot spend much time lately with the children due to the church construction. However, another missionary suggested a soccer game amongst four churches, and everyone had a good time together. Even though we came in last, we'll have extra motivation for next year.



★ Help build the church.

As mentioned before, the church construction has already started. The contract goes until April 2020, but I think it'll be closer to June, since the workers here work on their own schedule. I made three changes to the design drawings to keep it simpler due to the frequent flooding. Also, with the church being close to the river, we had to drill the shafts much deeper than originally designed. We started to drill 21 shafts at a depth of 9.4 meters.

Again, the goal is to invite a few teachers to teach the children after school hours, feed them, and raise soldiers of Christ. The building's original budget was \$235,000, but was reduced to \$180,000. If you can help me, I can handle it well. So far, JSBMF has been there for me, so I have gained strength and courage.

I will run for the gospel of Jesus Christ.

I will go to the spirit of salvation.

"I will make Christ honor in my body, whether I live or die" (Philippians 1:20).

I live or die, but I am the Lord, so I will walk down the narrow road until the day of the Lord's call.

May the glory of the Lord be filled with the JSBMF family. Thank you. Shalom.
