COL(R) Albert's father, Cornelius A. Albert, served in the Korean War from May 1951 through August 1952. He served as a rifleman with C Company, 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 38<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division. He was awarded the Combat Infantryman's Badge and both the American and ROK Presidential Unit Citations, COL(R) Albert's uncle's also fought in the Korean War. CPL **James C. Albert** served with the 1<sup>st</sup> Calvary division from August 1950 through August 1951. SFC Gerald R. Jacobson who was COL(R) mother's brother served with the 40<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division from January 1953 through December 1953. He was wounded while fighting on Hill 812 on 4 June 1953 and decorated for bravery
