1. Short-term missionary work (Shin Sung Sacred Christian Church, Suyeongro Church, Yeosu Saejungang Church)

This summer, three churches visited Kota Kinabalu for short-term missionary work. Until now, we were on the going end. However, it was a special experience to be on the receiving end of the short-term mission teams. It was very meaningful to influence the community positively through rich and diverse ministries.
