When I was lecturing, students would correct my pronunciation and I would spend a lot of energy trying to understand the stories of students coming from various regions. I feel grateful to the students who listened to the class well despite my lack of pronunciation and language skills. Some students study theology while working due to financial difficulties. Some students come to Bandung from distant islands to study theology. Looking at them, I look forward to the day when the gospel will bloom here in Indonesia, where 90% are Muslims. Choi began her Korean ministry for local elementary school students in July at her children's school. And she finished her ministry for the first semester in December and worked with 22 children to make kimbap. Choi got sick, but all the children who participated were more enjoyable than studying ^^:
