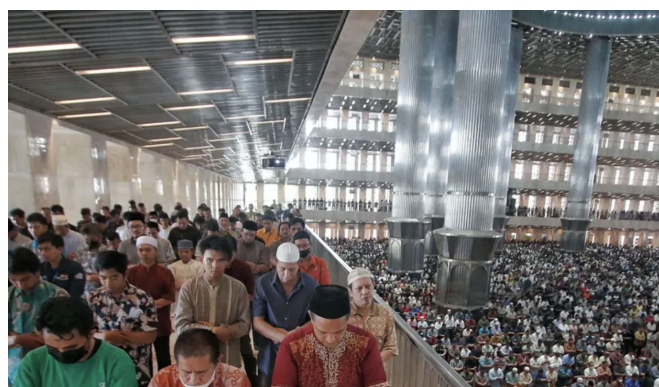
Shalom! I send you my prayer letter for March 2025, with the earnest hope that the gospel of the Kingdom of God will be spread among the Sundanese people.

Muslim Village Mission



Missionary Kim is working hard and praying to open a way to spread the gospel to Ciparai region with local missionaries. We have been visiting Muslim villages where there are no Christians. Some people's hearts have opened up a lot. So last February, my whole family visited this village and did ministry work. Since we cannot preach the gospel openly yet, Missionary Choi told children stories and did origami activities. Not only children, but also many adults participated and fellowshiped with them.



What I am thankful for is that after the ministry, I saw the history of three Sundanese locals hearing the gospel. It is forbidden to preach the gospel in this village. So I met them in the city and preached the gospel with the local missionary. Hallelujah! Please pray that the door of evangelism will open through them. I plan to carry out educational ministry in this village in the future. Please pray for this as well.

Missionaries Kim and Choi are attending a new local church. It is a small church with about 30 people gathering for worship, and they value us as missionaries. Even though I still lack the language skills, they continue to give me opportunities. So in January, I gave a testimony to the congregation, and in March, I preached at the adult worship service. Missionary Kim will be serving as a regular sermonist in the future. Missionary Choi continues to serve in an after-school Korean language class at a local elementary school. In addition to teaching Korean, she also teaches children's songs, fairy tales, and games, and this experience is being used in the Sundanese village ministry. So we are thankful for God's plan.



Please pray for our language skills so that we can speak the language well enough to preach and do children's ministry.

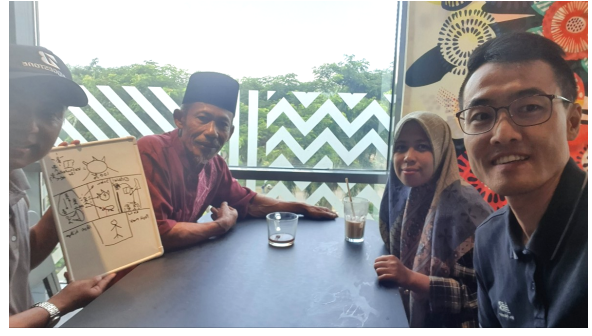
my children's story

The most difficult thing about living as a missionary in Indonesia is the visa. Even if there is fruit in the ministry, it is difficult to continue the ministry if the visa is not resolved. I have been on a student visa for two years, and I am preparing to receive a religious visa this time. However, the visa fee has recently increased significantly. In addition, I have to renew my house contract at the end of March before renewing my visa. In Indonesia, people pay annual rent and sign a house contract. That is a big financial burden for me.

Please pray for the visa fee for my family of five and the finances needed to renew the house contract.
